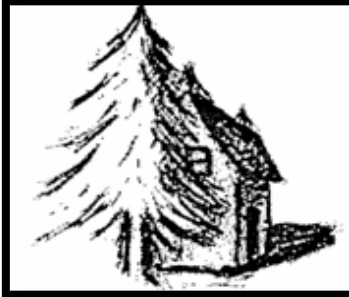

Youth Harmony Camp, is a weekend retreat for high school age boys who are interested in singing and want to learn more about the Barbershop style of harmony.

The structure of the camp consists of bringing about 100 boys together with four of the top barbershop clinicians in the country, two of the very best barbershop quartets in the country, and a whole lot of volunteer guys who help “make it happen”. Boys get turned on to a hobby that lasts a lifetime, they meet friends that last a lifetime, and they learn a skill and gain confidence in themselves that aids their success in their lives. Pretty big claims for just a weekend – but we see the magic happen every fall at Youth Harmony Camp.

During the weekend, the boys a) learn four or five songs to be sung at the Sunday “show” for their parents and friends, b) learn a great deal about proper breathing, posture and vowel shape for matching sound, c) sing dozens and dozens of “tags” (endings of songs) which are the most fun part of a song, d) meet new friends and most importantly have Fun.

Harmony Camp has been put on for about 16 years by the Far Western District of the Barbershop Harmony Society. This is our ninth year at Sly Park. Comments that we get back from Music Educators who have come to Camp along with their boys are that their boys come back really charged up and wanting to get their school program off the ground “right now”. We also hear stories of boys suddenly getting interested in school; ie. their choral program and even regular school. We like to say that this Camp has the potential for “changing lives”.

We encourage music educators to attend Harmony Camp as a guest of the Far Western District of the Barbershop Harmony Society. We value your expertise, input and comments and especially we value having your boys join with us and get excited about singing!

So send your boys, or come with them, to Sly Park Educational Center, Pollock Pines, California this coming September 23-25, 2011 for a weekend of fun and battery charging. Whether you utilize barbershop or not, your program will benefit from having your boys participate.
